#### Pay:

- Until March 11th
- For a new booking after March 11th, within 14 days or at the latest upon arrival

Winter storage: (Period: November 1, 2024 - April 1, 2025)

We ask that you pick up your boat, windsurf board and/or canoe with accessories by November 1st or let us know if you would like to spend the winter on land or in the marina.

- On land or in the marina, 25% of the seasonal rate
- On your own reserved pitch (seasonal guests), free of charge

#### **PORT RULES 2024**

- The berths are assigned by the harbor master; changing the berth without prior agreement is not permitted.
- The renter is responsible for ensuring that his boat and accessories are generously placed within the mooring box. Projecting parts outside the posts or over the bridge are not permitted. In the event of a violation, the berth fee will be adjusted and a suitable berth box will be assigned.
- You can launch and take your boat/windsurf board out of the water at the trailer ramp. If you want to bring loose items to your boat, you can use our wheelbarrows.
- Lifting: We have a lifting crane with an electric winch. Up to 750kg. This is operated exclusively by the harbor master, for which you can make an appointment.
- Parking of trailers: is only permitted after written confirmation, in the allocated space and provided that the trailer is marked with a clearly visible last name and guest number (available at reception) where the berth is reserved.
- Every boat must be moored to proper mooring lines, including on land and shelves. Do not attach the mooring lines too tightly as the water level fluctuates.
- Sunken and neglected boats must be salvaged after the first notice: failure to do so will be carried out by the harbor master at the owner's expense.
- Nailing or screwing is not permitted in masts, jetties and (bank) structures. All protection devices (flooring, fern, etc.) can be attached with tension straps or thin rope.
- It is not permitted to offer anything for rent or sale (for sale signs are prohibited).
- If you are taking your boat or windsurf board with you for longer than 3 days (e.g. for vacation somewhere else), please inform us. Cnossen Leekstermeer can temporarily rent open berths to passers-by without refunding the berth fees.
- A new or different boat than the one for which the berth was rented must first be registered with the harbor master.
- It is not permitted to sail or motorboat in the marina.
- Docking on land outside the marina is only permitted for rigging and unrigging sailboats and for embarking and disembarking passengers.
- The Harbour Master has the authority to deny access to the harbor, grounds or restrooms to visitors or owners of boats or windsurfing boards if he/she deems that the limits of courtesy have been exceeded.
- The harbor master is not liable for damage, destruction and/or theft or personal injury caused by defects in the yacht cabins and the premises.
- It is recommended that you take out all-risk insurance for your vessel. The owner of a vessel in the marina is liable for any damage caused by his vessel and/or his actions and/or the actions of his fellow passengers to the property of the harbor master and/or third parties.
- Always store windsurfing boards so that no parts protrude into another compartment.
- All your (loose) belongings should be marked with the last name on which they are reserved.
- Untraceable material will be removed after November 1st and retained for up to one year thereafter.
- Empty waste water and/or chemical toilet only in the chemical toilet located near the main sanitary facilities at the campsite.
- You should take bulky waste (old windsurfing boards, carpets, etc.) to a bulky waste dump yourself.
- Tarps for winter camping should be dark green/blue and not bright in color.

## **CONDITIONS FOR MOORING IN THE MARINA**

- The renter is responsible for ensuring that his boat and accessories are generously placed within the berth. If, in the opinion of the harbor master, this is not the case, another place will be allocated and the corresponding fee will be charged.
- Payment will be made according to the aforementioned schedule or within 14 days of booking.
